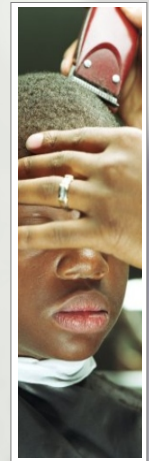

Mission: To prepare students in their chosen profession and to instill in them the Importance of good public relations.

Admission Procedures: Enrollment is done during the hours of 10 a.m. to 4 p.m, Tuesday- Friday. At the time of enrollment, please submit all necessary documentation and required fees. Individuals seeking financial assistance must submit a complete application and provide the school with the needed supporting documentation.

Enrollment will not be approved until the financial aid process has been completed.

Admission Requirements;

1. The following items are required by all applicants to be eligible for enrollment: completed enrollment application, valid drivers' license, and social security card needed.
2. Proof of education: provide completion of 7th grade with official transcript, high school diploma, G.E.D. or pass an independent test (ability to benefit) administered by certified tester at the school. Test can be retaken if unsuccessful the first time. There is a fee for testing
3. State registration fee of \$35.00 must be in form of a money order payable to: Trend Barber College.
4. Four 2 x 2 photos with the same pose. These may be obtained from any Walgreens, CVS, or mall. May also be taken at school for \$6.00.

All students must attend classes for the schedule daily hours. Full-time students must accumulate a total of 120 clock hours a month and part-time students must accumulate 60 clock hours a month.

School attendance on **SATURDAY IS MANDATORY.** Saturdays are devoted exclusively to practical work over the chair to fulfill the Texas Department of Licensing and regulation requirement; all students must adhere to all policies and procedures.

There is a **ZERO TOLERANCE** Level for disobeying school and state officials, school rules and regulations, stealing, and disrespect to customers. No weapons of any kind are allowed in the school building or any school sponsored event. Possession of any weapons (knives, guns, switch blades etc.) any dangerous object could result

in an immediate expulsion.

Course Completion (Barber Stylist Program)

To complete the program all students must accumulate 1500 clock hours. Full time students are to complete the program in no less than nine (9) months. Financial Aid Recipients must be in school for 12 months full time, and 18 months part time

Part-Time student * see instructor

All students must pass a comprehensive written and practical exit exam with a grade of 75% or better before taking the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation examination.

Previous Training: This college accepts a maximum of 500 clock hours from any barber school or college.

Completion and Graduation Rates:

Trend Barber College has a 60% completion rate and 90% graduation rate. Students find it difficult to complete the program because of financial reason. This is why Trend Barber College adopted the loan system to enable students to borrow money while in school so they could complete the program of study.

Trend Barber College does not have a uniformed guard at the school. There is a Houston police substation located in close proximity to the school if we should need their service. There has not been any crime in the school. The crime statistics at the building are zero.

Withdrawal Policy:

A student who wishes to drop out of the program for reasons known or unknown to the school is advised to put the request in writing. In the event the student did not inform the admissions department, the school calls the student after 2 or 3 days of absence. If there is no communication with the student after 10 school days of consecutive absences, the school will begin the official withdrawal of the student and return of Title IV is then calculated.

BARBER STYLIST PROGRAM:

This program consists of 1,320 clock hours of practical application and 180 clock hours of general theory for a total of 1,500 clock hour that must be completed.
